MEMORANDIUM FOR RECORD:

SUBJECT: Policy letter: Chapter Distinguished Rider Program

1. This policy letter remains in effect for 18 months or until an updated Chapter By-Laws is approved. Any changes to this policy must be made to the full policy letter.
2. The Distinguished Rider Program (DRP) has been developed to serve one important function. To encourage CVMA members to ride their motorcycles, preferably with their CVMA family.
3. DRP Guidelines define who is eligible for the patch and chevrons as:
 - a. motorcycle rider and auxiliary passengers
 - b. members who are deemed clinically unable to ride, but attends the ride using an alternate means of transportation
4. Allowable Mileage
 - a. riding to Chapter approved meetings on a 500cc or larger motorcycle that is owned and operated by the owner. These rides can be solo or group
5. Logging Mileage
 - a. At the completion of the ride, the rider will send an e-mail to the Chapter QM email with a picture of odometer
 - b. the subject for the email should be "Mileage Report - date"
6. Patches and Chevrons
 - a. The Chapter QM will maintain a stock of DRP patches and chevrons for award to the individual who have reached approved mileage milestones.
